# Building MUSIC LITERACY PROGRAM

**The TD Building Music Literacy Program** is dedicated to introducing jazz and blues music and its history to our community, especially school-age kids. Harvest has always placed a great deal of importance on these investments as it is fundamental to our community vision.

### **TD Congo Square**

Our free fun family event that's all about the music—bring the kids to Officers' Square Saturday, September 15 at 11:00 am! Fredericton's children's performers Scotty and the Stars will kick the kids' concert off with other acts to follow.

Children also love our Instrument Petting Zoo, with a hands-on opportunity for kids to play a variety of

instruments. For the budding artists, there is a T-shirt painting station.

### **TD Music in the Schools Grant Program**

Our **TD Community Music Funding Program**, provides financial contributions to the Fredericton Music Festival as well as local area school music and band programs with the goal of developing young musicians and building the musical capacity of our community. To date, Harvest has donated close to \$140,000 to local area schools to buy or repair instruments, purchase sheet music, and provide prizes for various instrumental and band categories at the Fredericton Music Festival.

The program is proudly funded through a variety of efforts conducted by our volunteers

and partners: all tips collected at Harvest bars and venues are donated, you can donate online when you purchase your Harvest tickets and passes, and there are countless 50/50 and live-art fundraisers throughout Harvest week!

### **Mavis Staples**

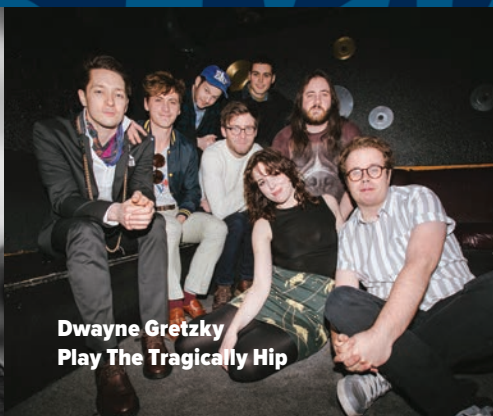

She's a Kennedy Center honoree, Rock and Roll and Blues Halls of Fame member, and Bob Dylan asked her father Pops Staples for her hand in marriage. Dubbed "the epitome of soul," her latest offering, *If All I Was Was Black*, leads listeners through a soundscape that mixes joy and social criticism over a funk-edged sound.
